Based on the Memorandum of Understanding between UNEP and Young Agenda 21, the committee is equally represented by both parties and makes final decisions on the programme and budget of the conference.

The final programme proposal will be presented to the committee by UNEP, following contributions from the Norway Organising Committee and the Junior Board.
