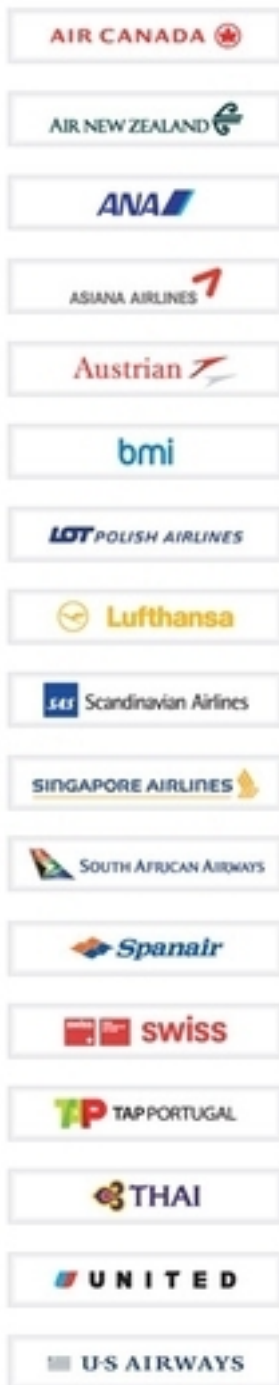
(13.03.2008) Arrival to Stavanger should be on Sunday 15 or Monday morning 16 June, and departure on Saturday 21 June. Delegates who have been selected for the conference and who have not been offered travel grants, must purchase their own air ticket. If you need a visa, you should not buy the ticket before the visa has been issued. - The international airport code of Stavanger Airport Sola is SVG.
